USDA Announces MFP Payment Details

On July 25th, USDA announced the final details of the \$16 billion trade aid package to support U.S. producers while the Trump Administration continues with its ongoing trade negotiations.

Market Facilitation Program (MFP): \$14.5 billion in direct payments will be made to farmers in up to three tranches; with sign-up currently taking place at local Farm Serve Agency offices until December 6th. The first payment will be made in mid-to-late august and will be the highest of either 50% of a producers expected payment or \$15 per acre. Depending on the status of the trade negotiations and market conditions, the second and third tranches will be made in November and early January.

Agricultural Trade Promotion Program (ATP): \$100 million will be distributed to 48 cooperating organizations – including \$6.9 million to the U.S. Grains Council and \$230,000 to the Brewers Association – to develop new markets and help mitigate the effects of tariff and non-tariff barriers of other countries.

Food Purchase and Distribution Program (FPDP): \$1.4 million will be used to purchase surplus commodities through the Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS) for distribution through the Food Nutrition Service (FNS).

NBGA Washington representative Tom Hance attended a National Economists Club "Economics of Beer" event that featured a presentation by Michael Uhrich, Chief Economist at the Beer Institute. The event was held at the Anheuser-Busch Washington, DC office facility and included discussion on barley and hops production and the impact of current trade issues on the beer industry value chain.



NBGA Joins Letter Urging Senate Minority Leader Schumer to Fill Democratic Vacancy on Surface Transportation Board

Barley growers and our industry value chain partners have a strong interest in railroad issues and policies. The Surface Transportation Board (STB), which oversees the railroad industry currently has a vacant Board seat that limits its ability to conduct necessary oversight activities. In an effort to have the vacancy filled, NBGA joined American Malting Barley Association and the Beer Institute on a letter to Senate Minority Leader Chuck Schumer (D-NY) urging him to move quickly on nominating a candidate to fill the position of Deb Miller whose term expired at the end of 2018.

USDA Ag Trade Promotion

The USDA awarded an additional \$100 million to organizations through the Agricultural Trade Promotion Program. The Brewers Association received \$230,000 and the U.S. Grains Council received \$6,883,310.

NBGA Signs Testimony for Grain Standards Act Hearing

Although issues specific to other crops are not addressed by this statement, the following groups – American Farm Bureau Federation, American Soybean Association, National Barley Growers Association, National Corn Growers Association, National Farmers Union, National Sunflower Association, U.S. Canola Association, U.S. Pea and Lentil Trade Association, and USA Dry Pea and Lentil Council – also agree that a properly functioning grain inspection system

is critical, and on behalf of all of our organizations, we urge Congress to reauthorize the Grain Standards Act this year for at least five years. The 2015 reauthorization of the Grain Standards Act included many improvements and we hope to continue and build upon those improvements through this reauthorization.
